ORDER

Due to Covid-19 lockdown imposed by the Government of Tamil Nadu this Commission due to the constraint of conducting the enquiry in person, conducts the enquiry through telephone and online. Hence this case was taken in to enquiry on 09.11.2020 through telephone. During the enquiry the petitioner Thiru R. Subramanian has not attended the telephone and the Public Information Officer, Tamil Nadu Government Transport Corporation, Villupuram Division, Villupuram were present.

2. A perusal of the petition dated 24.09.2018 filed under section 6(1) of the R.T.I. Act, 2005 reveals that the petitioner is working as Selection Grade Conductor in Tamil Nadu Government Transport Corporation Villupuram Division at Puducherry Deport and he needs a copy of his Service Register, Copies of increment sanction orders from the year 2007 to 2018 and a copy of the arrear bill passed for Rs.1,54,611/- As, no information has been provided by the Public Information Officer, the petitioner has preferred a First Appeal dated 02.11.2018 under section 19(1) of the RTI Act, 2005 followed by this Second Appeal under section 19(3) of the RTI Act, 2005 before this Commission on 10.12.2018 and the said appeal was ordered vide SA9452/F/2018 dated 16/04/2019 to provide the information to the petitioner within 30 days of receipt of the order. As the Public Information Officer has not provided the information the petitioner has submitted a petition on Non-Compliance dated 31.07.2019 and hence this case was taken up for today's (09.11.2020) enquiry.

3. During the enquiry the petitioner has not attended the telephone and as per the Non Compliance petition to the Commission dated 31.07.2019, he has not received any information.

4. During the enquiry, the Public Information Officer requested the Commission to grant 15 days time limit to provide the information to the Petitioner.

5. In the facts and circumstances of this case, this Commission finds that information sought by the petitioner was not completely provided to the petitioner. Hence, the Public Information Officer is hereby ordered:

- The Public Information Officer is hereby ordered to submit a complete written explanation for the delay of two years in providing the requisite information within 7 days from the date of receipt of this order.
- The Public Information Officer is hereby ordered to provide the complete information to the petitioner by RPAD within 7 days under Section 7(6) of Right to Information Act from the date of receipt of this order and report compliance to this Commission.
- The Commission further orders that if the Public Information Officer fails to provide requisite information during the said period of 7 days action will be initiated under section 20(1) of the Right to Information Act.
