The Petitioner Thiru V. Vijayaprakash was present for today's (24.09.2009) enquiry. The Public Authority was represented by the Assistant Public Information Officer Thiru R. Thangarathinam, Assistant Commissioner (CRB), Chennai Suburban Police, St. Thomas Mount, Chennai - 16 and Tmt. M. Nayeemunisha, Sub Inspector of Police, W-3 All Women Police Station, Tambaram, Chennai - 45.

Under the RTI Act 2005 sec.6(1) the petitioner sent a petition dated 15.04.09 addressed to the PIO (Joint Commissioner of Police (South), Chennai-16) requesting him to provide information on 6 items with regard to petitioner's petition enquiry dated 08.10.08 and provide the information on 5 items with regard to F.I.R. No.21/08 dated 10.11.08. The concerned PIO sent reply to the petitioner on 19.5.09. Not satisfied with the reply given by the PIO, the petitioner filed the 1st Appeal under sec.19(1) to the Appellate Authority on 17.6.09 and the 2nd Appeal under sec.19(3) to the Commission on 29.6.09. On the basis of the petitioner's second Appeal to the Commission both the Petitioner and the PIO were summoned to appear before the Commission for today's hearing.

At the enquiry, the petitioner informed the Commission that the information on 6 items and 5 items supplied by the PIO was incorrect and misleading. But the PIO has stated that correct information was supplied to the petitioner and also the PIO produced an Affidavit to that effect that the information given on 6 items and 5 items was correct and not misleading. Since the Affidavit was submitted by the PIO before the Commission the case is treated as closed.
